13oz. Claw Hammer Directions

- 1. Grasp hammer firmly at the middle of the handle white mark
- 2. With other hand, hold nail firmly in its proposed location (Best results are achieved when the pointed end is driven into the wood).
- 3. Tap nail sharply on the head.
- 4. Remove hand from nail; failure to do so may result in serious injury.
- 5. Regrasp hammer handle near the end away from the hammer head (this provides additional mechanical advantage)
- 6. Strike nail firmly on the head with a smart rap; this will entrench the nail into the wood
- 7. Retreat slightly and strike the nail (on the head) with severe blows.
- 8. Repeat step #7 as required.
- 9. Stand back and admire work
- 10. Return hammer to its position on the shed wall

Notes:

- 1. Should injury result due to carlessness in step 4, utilize a suitable biblical passage to relieve the pain. For prolonged pain recite the 23rd psalm.
- 2. If nails repeatedly split the wood;
 - (a) Use a smaller nail
 - (b) Blunt the point of the nail prior to driving it
- 3. For nail removal directs (ie. the proper use of the claw on a claw hammer) consult Albert.
